We also place great importance on personal privacy and handle it with extreme care. We do not allow the sharing of personal data with any party or individual under any circumstances except pursuant to orders from competent authorities.

### **Definition of the Privacy Policy of Elite Training Center**

### **What Personal Data Do We Collect and Why?**

#### **1. Comments**

When visitors leave comments on the website, we collect the data shown in the comments form, along with the visitor’s IP address and browser user agent string to help detect spam.

#### **2. Media**

If you upload images to the website, you should avoid uploading images that contain embedded location data (EXIF GPS). Visitors to the website may download and extract location data from images posted on the site.

#### **3. Contact Forms**

#### **Cookies**

If you leave a comment on our site, you may choose to save your name, email address, and website in cookies. This is for your convenience so you do not have to fill in your details again when leaving another comment. These cookies last for one year.

If you visit our login page, we will set a temporary cookie to determine whether your browser accepts cookies. This cookie contains no personal data and is discarded when you close your browser.

When you log in, we also set several cookies to save your login information and screen display preferences. Login cookies last for two days, and screen options cookies last for one year. If you select "Remember Me," your login will persist for two weeks. If you log out, login cookies will be removed.

An additional cookie will be saved in your browser when you edit or publish an article. This cookie contains no personal data and simply indicates the post ID of the article you edited. It expires after one day.

### **Embedded Content from Other Websites**

Articles on this website may include embedded content (such as videos, images, and articles). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the same way as if the visitor visited the other website directly.

These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with the embedded content, including tracking your interaction if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

### **Analytics**

#### **Who We Share Your Data With**

If you request a password reset, your IP address will be included in the reset email.

#### **How Long We Retain Your Data**

If you leave a comment, the comment and its metadata are retained indefinitely. This allows us to automatically recognize and approve follow-up comments instead of holding them in a moderation queue.

For users who register on our website (if applicable), we store the personal information they provide in their user profile. All users can view, edit, or delete their personal information at any time (except they cannot change their username). Website administrators can also see and edit that information.

#### **What Rights You Have Over Your Data**

If you have an account on this site or have left comments, you can request an exported file of the personal data we hold about you, including any data you provided to us. You may also request that we erase any personal data we hold about you. This does not include any data we are obliged to keep for administrative, legal, or security purposes.

## **Where Your Data Is Sent**

**Elite Training Center** retains your data and does not send it to other parties.

## **Your Rights and How to Exercise Them**

Privacy laws grant you certain rights regarding the data we hold about you, including:

1. The right to obtain a copy of the personal data we hold about you. Reasonable administrative fees may apply for additional copies.
2. The right to correct inaccurate personal data.
3. The right to request deletion of your personal data in certain circumstances (“right to be forgotten”).
4. The right to request that we stop using your personal data for marketing purposes.
5. The right to request temporary restrictions on how we process your personal data in certain circumstances.
6. If processing is based on your consent, you may withdraw that consent at any time.
7. For security purposes, we may request proof of identity before processing such requests.
8. If you are not satisfied with how we handle your personal data, you may contact us to resolve the matter or file a complaint with the relevant data protection authority.
